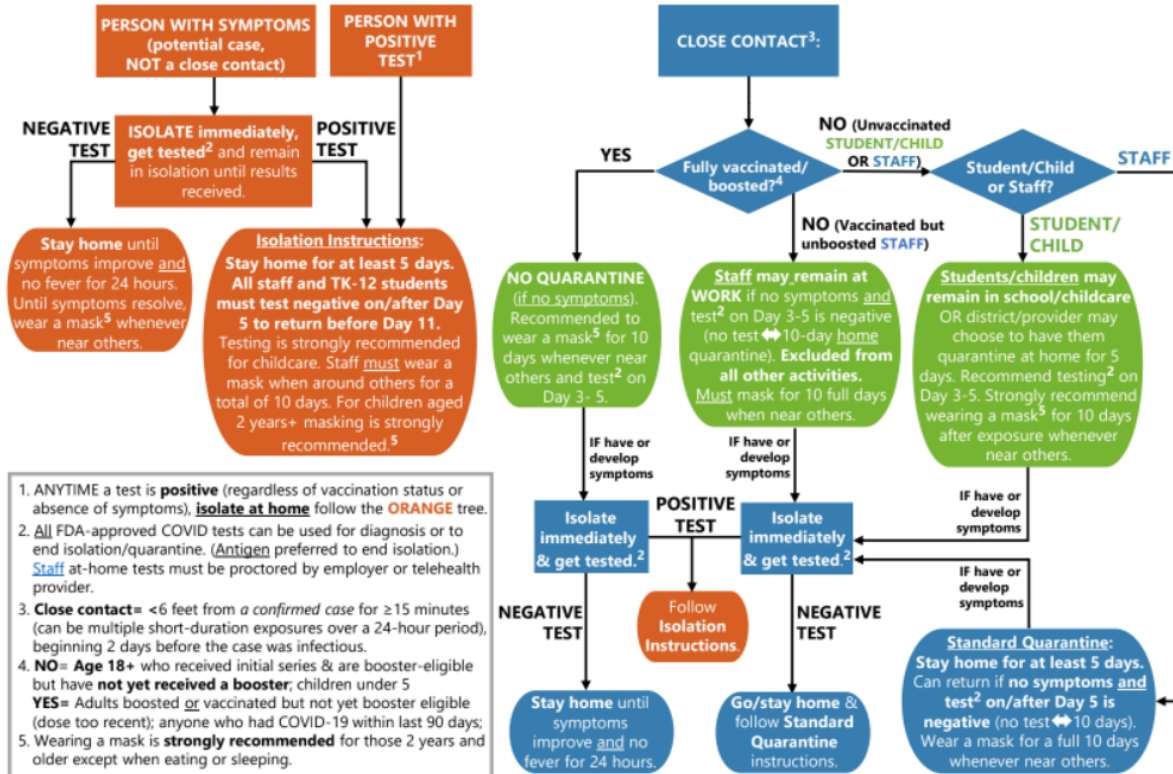

Updated Decision Tree

Per CDPH/SCCPH:

- A positive case can test on Day 5. If that test is negative, they can return on on Day 6. If they test positive still, they can come back as soon as they test negative (after Day 5) as long as they feel good and are fever free for 24 hours. We recommend to test again on Day 7.
- If a student or staff does not test, then they need to isolate for the full 10 days.
- No test is needed to return to school if isolation lasts the full 10 days.

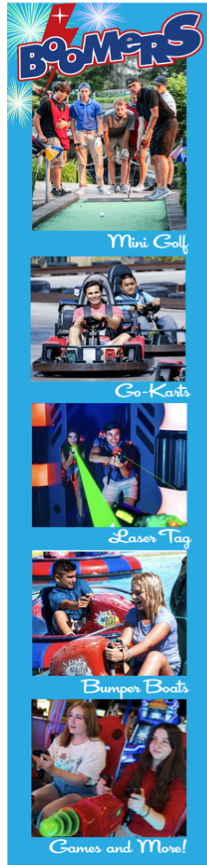
