MCAULIFFE MIDDLE SCHOOL PROMOTION INFORMATION FOR EIGHTH GRADERS

Academic and Behavior Responsibilities

In conjunction with the district rules and regulations regarding student behavior and in an effort to make promotion to high school and the activities surrounding it more meaningful, each member of the eighth grade class needs to be aware of the following requirements:

GENERAL

- 1. Eighth graders are students of this school until the completion of all end-of-year activities. All policies, rules, and regulations are in effect until the completion of all school-related activities.
- 2. In order to participate in the promotional and end-of-year activities, all eighth graders must complete the required course of study and have a satisfactory attendance record.

Eligibility for 8th grade students can be withdrawn if meeting the following criteria:

Grades: Students who have received multiple F's and/or N's and U's on either semester report card are subject to removal from the year-end activities and 8th Grade Promotion. Spring semester grades will be examined on an ongoing basis beginning May 12th.

Demerits: Students who have 10 or more disciplinary demerit points as of May 12, 2022 will not participate in the year-end activities or the eighth grade promotion ceremony.

Suspension/Saturday School: Any member of the eighth grade class who receives a suspension and/or "Saturday School," may be excluded from eighth grade activities and/or the promotion exercises.

LIBRARY, TEXTBOOK, AND EQUIPMENT CHARGES

All library books, textbooks, and equipment must be returned, and/or payment must be made for all missing items. It is the responsibility of each eighth grade student to clear any charges by May 12, 2022. **Eighth Grade students with school debts will not receive their yearbook** or be allowed to participate in the eighth grade activities and/or promotion exercise.

PROMOTION BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

- 1. The promotion exercise is a serious event. Students are not to bring any items that may cause a disruption or detract from the dignity of the exercise.
- 2. Any student who does not abide by all school rules and regulations during any eighth grade activity or the promotional exercises may be suspended and removed from the activity.
- 3. No cell phones or gum will be permitted.

DRESS CODE

The **school dress code** will be enforced at the daytime promotion assembly. Nice school clothes, business attire, or simple party dresses are appropriate:

Guidelines: Buttoned and/or collared shirts, long pants, and shoes. Ripped or torn jeans and t-shirts are NOT permitted. Dresses, skirts outfits, and pants outfits. Strapless or backless dresses or tops, outfits with a revealing neckline, or formal prom-like gowns are NOT permitted.

Students may wear scarves, wraps, or sweaters over necklines that do not comply with these standards. Please keep in mind that students will be on an artificial turf field. Pointed heals are prohibited, as they will destroy the field. Only wedges or flats are allowed. Also keep in mind that students are walking across an elevated stage. To ensure appropriate appearance, dresses and skirts should be no more than a few inches above the knee.

STUDENTS MAY BE EXCLUDED FROM ACTIVITIES FOR INAPPROPRIATE DRESS AND/OR BEHAVIOR.

Students may NOT DRIVE themselves to field trip activities.
