

High School Parking Registration and Rules

Paradise Valley Unified School District

District high schools have a limited number of parking spaces available for student use. Spaces will be allocated using a permit system at the discretion of the administration. Parking on school grounds is a privilege and rules violations may result in the revocation of parking privileges. Student driver responsibilities:

1. Student drivers must hold a valid state of Arizona driver license and must have a valid Arizona registration for their vehicle. ARS 28-2001 defines a resident as "a person who places children in a public school without payment of nonresident tuition."
2. Students must drive safely on school property and obey parking regulations. Any misconduct involving automobiles or other discipline issues may result in the loss of parking privileges in addition to other disciplinary consequences.
3. After students arrive on campus, they are not permitted to access their vehicles until the end of their school day. Students may not loiter in the parking lots before, during or after school.
4. Students who drive to school must register with the high school office. Only registered vehicles are permitted in parking areas. Parking decals must be displayed on the inside left bottom front windshield.
5. It is the student's responsibility to report vehicle changes and present valid Arizona registration for the new vehicle to the assistant principal's office, and to transfer the registration decal from the former vehicle to the new vehicle. If the registered car is in an accident, sold or the windshield replaced, it is the student's responsibility to retrieve the decal. There may be a cost to replace a decal.
6. Students may not sell or give their decal to another student, or purchase a decal for another student. Misuse may result in the loss of your parking privileges and you may not be eligible for a refund.
7. Neither the school nor the Paradise Valley School District are responsible for damage to or theft of, or from, any vehicle.
8. All fees must be paid (excluding senior graduating fees) before a permit will be issued. Qualifying seniors and juniors will be issued permits on a first-come, first-served basis. Other qualifying grade-level students will be placed on a waiting list.
9. A full parking lot is not an excuse for parking in an unapproved area. Vehicles must be parked properly within striped parking stalls and are restricted to a speed of five miles per hour on school property. Only authorized persons with identification are permitted to access parking lots during the regular school day and school year.

Parking decal fees are purchased for a full year. The fee is based on the date of purchase; fees are prorated by quarter.
