



## TES RESIDENCY NOTICE

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| <p>It is important that we determine with absolute certainty a child's place of residency. To meet the State of Vermont's definition of residency, a student must have a parent or legal guardian who resides in the town in which a child will be attending school. A student who is in the sole custody of a parent who is NOT living in town but may be living with her or her non-custodial parent in town is still NOT considered a resident. "Residence" means the place that a person actually lives. Residency requirements are NOT met if one owns property, has a post office box or owns a business in town. If you do not meet the state's residency requirements for a particular town, your child is not a resident of that town. The town's school, therefore, is not obligated to pay tuition or provide education.</p> |                    |
