



## Affidavit of Support

### Financial Declaration Requirements and Affidavit of Support

If you are admitted to The Newman School, we can provide you with an I-20 (F-1) only after you submit satisfactory evidence that you have adequate funds for your proposed program of study. Acceptable financial documents must have been issued (by the financial institution) within 6 months of the date the application was submitted with the Affidavit of Support (below) if necessary. Be sure to keep copies of your financial documents as you will need to present them to the US Consular Officer at your visa interview and to the US Immigration Officers at the Port of Entry.

### Criteria for Financial Documentation

All funds must be available in liquid assets. Non-liquid assets are not acceptable forms of documentation and cannot be accepted. Documentation must be legible and in English. You must provide the specific amount and the currency of the funds available.

**Examples of acceptable documentation:** Personal bank statement (checking/savings), parents or personal sponsor bank statement, government agency letter of award for scholarship to study.

**Examples of unacceptable documentation:** stock holdings, life insurance policies, employment letters, credit lines and mortgages, payroll reports, statements regarding property, jewelry, cars, and other non-liquid assets, statements lacking currency amounts.

### Required Funds

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**Suggested Minimum \$60,500**

*Note: The signed "Affidavit of Support" must show sufficient funding for the total amount given above. Multiple affidavits should be used if more than one sponsor is giving money in support of the student.*

**To be completed by parent/personal sponsor whose name is on the financial documents:**

Relatives and other personal sponsors are required to complete the "Affidavit of Support" form when funds held in their name are provided as financial documentation by an international student at time of application. The Affidavit of Support helps confirm the legitimacy of financial documentation presented by the student.
