Process to Purchase Tickets:

- Tickets will be on sale **ONLY through orgs ONLINE**. You must pay before receiving your tickets.
- All Permission slips will be filled out online.
- ****Students we are giving you the power!**** Let us know who you want to sit with, tables fit 10, PLUS allergies and other fun stuff. Don't care where you sit? Let us know that too!
- **Ticket Sales run from 5/3/2022 – 9pm on 5/13/2022**

Guests:

Students who would like to bring a guest from outside of AMSA must pick up and return the *Prom Guest Permission Form* signed by the student's administrator and parents prior to Friday, May 13th. All guests must be under the age of **21**. Forms can be found with Ms. Paille and Mrs. Deady.

Transportation

A white coach bus to and from prom is included in the ticket price. A second bus will be available to take After Prom Students to the YMCA in Westborough. Buses will leave AMSA for Mt Wachusett at 4:00 p.m. SHARP. Students attending the after-prom party will be dropped off at the Boroughs Family YMCA in Westborough, MA after the prom. You **MUST** sign up for the bus online during the orgs Check out process. **STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DRIVE THEMSELVES TO PROM but can drive themselves to AMSA for the bus.**

After Prom Information

After the prom, students are given two options.

- The first is to be dropped back off at AMSA with a bus. Students can go home for the evening by either parent pick up or driving themselves *home*.
- The second option is the **AFTER PROM** that is run by the PTO. (*See PTO After Prom Packet - their sign up in on Square and turn in forms to Margie Deady*)
 - This is an AWESOME alternative to other end of night activities.
 - There is a nominal fee for a worry free night.
 - Students will be bused to After Prom straight from the Prom and will be spending the night there. Limos are encouraged to drop off their charges at After Prom as well.
 - If a student did not attend Prom or went home first; parents can drop them off up until midnight! After Prom Doors CLOSE at MIDNIGHT!
 - *Parent pick will be from 4:30am - 5 am at the YMCA parking lots.*
 - NO STUDENT is allowed to drive themselves home from After Prom!
 - Students should pack a small over night bag – basically a change of comfy clothes, a bathing suit, towel and hanger for their dress/tux. Deodorant, phone chargers and water bottles are highly encouraged to bring as well.

Bag Drop off will be behind the upper school Thursday 5/26 at 8 am and 3:15 pm with Prom Committee Advisors.

Additional Information:

During the Mock tail hour, students will have the opportunity to ride the ski lift to the top of Mt. Wachusett. Be mindful that even though this is the end of May it will be cool at the top of the mountain and while on the lift. It is suggested that students who do not have a jacket as part of their ensemble, think about bringing a shawl, sweater, or light jacket for the trip up the mountain.

Note: there is not great service at Mt Wachusett outside of the ski lodge. Students are encouraged to charge their phones before they leave, or bring an additional battery/charger pack for their phones. There are limited wall sockets and there is no guarantee that the student will be able to access one. If students are going to after prom it is encouraged that they pack a charger for their phone in their bag.
