Liability Waiver

Please read and sign at the top of Page 2. THIS PAGE DOES NOT NEED TO BE HANDED IN. Please keep on hand for future reference. Event info at bottom.

I/We promise to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the sponsors, AMSA Charter School, its officers, employees, agents, volunteers, and anyone assisting in the program from responsibility from any and all associated losses, claim of loss, injury, damage or expenses, of whatever kind and nature, including attorney's fees, which I/We may have or acquire as the parent(s) or guardian(s) of said minor arising out of or resulting, directly or indirectly, from travel to or participation in this event. I/We also release and discharge AMSA Charter School from any and all claims, damages, losses or expenses of whatever kind or nature, including attorney's fees, which said minor may have or acquire arising out of or resulting from, directly or indirectly, from travel to or participation in this event. I/We furthermore agree to defend and indemnify AMSA Charter School against any claim, damage, loss or expense of whatever kind or nature that AMSA Charter School may have to pay that arises from said minor's intentional, grossly negligent, or reckless acts or omissions while participating in the event.

I/We have determined the nature and extent of the planned activities, and feel that this participant is of sufficient age, ability and discretion to participate. I agree that this participation will be at the discretion of the AMSA Charter School. Permission is hereby given to AMSA employees or agents who are supervising the student to act on our behalf in authorizing and consenting to emergency medical care for the student while participating in the After Prom in the event of injury or illness. Unless noted on this form, the participant has no allergies or other problems which will interfere with normal participation. I/We hereby release and discharge AMSA Charter School from any and all claims of any nature whatsoever, which may arise out of the decision to provide emergency medical care.

I give permission to the Boroughs Family Branch YMCA and chaperones of the AMSA After Prom event to secure medical treatment for my child if needed. I further agree to hold AMSA Charter School and the chaperones blameless for any accidents that might occur during this event except for clear acts of negligence or non-adherence to the YMCA policies and guidelines.
