HEAD, HEART, HANDS & HEALTH <u>4-H Camp</u> is a part of the beautiful Seven Mountains Scout Camp in Spring Mills, Pennsylvania. The camp week will be shared with 4-H youth from Carbon, Lehigh, Monroe, Northampton, and Schuylkill Counties.



Facilities: Seven Mountains consists of two cabin areas, each with multiple bunk beds, indoor toilets, and common sitting area. Campers of similar age and gender will be housed together. Gender Neutral Housing will be made available, if requested– please contact Kelly Weisner in the Lehigh office. Counselors will be housed in cabin areas. Additional amenities include: central dinning hall, campfire amphitheater, lake front activities, swimming pool, pavilions, hiking trails, and recreation areas.

<u>Staff</u>: A camp director, extension staff, and adult volunteer chaperones will be present at all times. Trained counselors will be present in every cabin area and will supervise all activities.



<u>Health Forms</u>: All required camp forms will be provided upon registration. Medical treatment forms, youth code of conduct, media release, and administration of medication forms are due by **June 10, 2022** to your county 4-H Educator. Print forms, complete them, and mail them to your County Extension office **BEFORE** camp. Campers may not attend without these forms!

Fees: The \$400 fee for campers and \$200 fee for counselors cover lodging, meals, craft supplies, and activities. Partial scholarships are available—contact your county 4-H Office **prior** to registering online for information. Scholarship application deadline is **May 5th**—no exceptions! The \$400 fee is a **discounted price for EARLY registration**.

Transportation: Families are responsible for arranging transportation to and from drop-off and pick-up site. All youth will take a bus to and from camp. Carpooling to and from the bus stop is suggested for campers. Bus stops include Penn State Extension offices in Northampton and Lehigh Counties and Cabela's in Hamburg.
