Series 300: Instruction

EVALUATION/APPROVAL OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

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The director of instruction shall be responsible for the evaluation of instructional programs. He/she shall coordinate an organized approach to periodic program evaluation that meets at least minimum state standards. This approach shall call for all programs to be formally evaluated at least once every five years.

The director of instruction shall work with the superintendent and the Board of Education Curriculum Committee to communicate the need for new or revised programs. All changes, additions or deletions of curriculum programs shall be reviewed by this Curriculum Committee with appropriate recommendations gong to the full Board for action.
