Series 400: Students

FULL TIME STUDENT

412.1

K-8:

Students enrolled in grades K through 8 are defined as full time students if they are enrolled in classes throughout the normal school day, or enrolled in an equivalent alternative program supported by District funds.

9-12:

Students in high school (9-12) must be enrolled in high school credit or in equivalent non-credit/credit alternative program supported by District funds or the number of classes enabling the students to meet graduation requirements during the school year to be considered full time students.

Every student in grades 9-12 shall be either in a regularly scheduled class, study hall, or a school-sponsored and supervised work experience program or other Board approved program each hour of the school day.

Students may also be excused from attendance as part of the "Responsibility Release" program.

Individual Exceptions (CWD):

Individual student schedules and attendance at school may deviate from the schedule presented above, if special needs of the student dictate such deviation. Such deviation shall be specifically outlined in a student IEP (Individualized Educational Plan).
