PARTICIPATION OF NON-PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS IN DISTRICT PROGRAMS

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Residents of the Waunakee Community School District enrolled in a private school, parochial school or home-based private educational program may participate in public school courses and programs as follows:

- 1. A non-public school student may take up to two courses per semester at Waunakee Community High School provided the following conditions are met: (a) the student is eligible for high school admission and has met any established prerequisites for the courses(s), (b) the student resides in the District, and (c) there is sufficient space in the classroom.
- 2. A non-public school resident student may participate in the 6th grade band program subject to the following conditions:
 - Permitted only if sufficient space is available
 - Permitted if there is no additional cost to the District
 - A homeschooled/private school student will be removed from the course(s) permanently if attendance is irregular, behavior interferes with the quality of the program or rights of others, or if the student is not meeting the criteria for participation normally expected of other students in the program or activity.
 - Transportation to and from the District course or program shall be the responsibility of the student's parent/guardian
 - Applications will only be considered for participation for a full grading period, season, or event.
 - The district will not provide special education services for home school students.
- 3. A non-public school resident student may participate in 7th and 8th grade athletics.
