STUDENT REPRESENTATION TO THE BOARD

442.2

The Board of Education recognizes the unique perspective on issues impacting the District held by students. Therefore, the Board shall welcome a student representative to the Board. This student (of his/her alternate) shall represent the views of students enrolled in the District on agenda items discussed at regularly scheduled Board meetings.

The student representative shall:

- 1) not be able to vote on any issue before the Board.
- 2) be excluded from closed sessions of the Board.
- 3) be encouraged to sit at the Board table and be free to enter into discussion or answer questions in the same manner as elected Board members.
- 4) represent all students in the District and communicate with student councils at all buildings and levels -- not just the high school.
- 5) be a junior or senior at the high school and begin his/her term on June 1st.
- 6) be selected by the Waunakee Community High School Student Council to serve on an annual basis. The Student Council shall select an alternate to serve during the absence of the selected representative.
