

PUBLIC ACCESS DEFIBRILLATION PROGRAM

An important part of a comprehensive emergency response plan in the Waunakee Community School District includes the use of defibrillation via semiautomatic external defibrillators, commonly known as automated external defibrillators (AEDs).

Placement and Maintenance:

Five Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) will be maintained on the premises of:

Specific locations of AEDs within the buildings will be determined by a Crisis Response Team. The locations will be easily accessible to the general public and will be near a telephone. The nearest local EMS will receive written notification as to the type, location, owner, and intended usage areas for the AEDs. Maintenance and testing of the AEDs will be conducted as required by any operational guidelines of the manufacturer.
