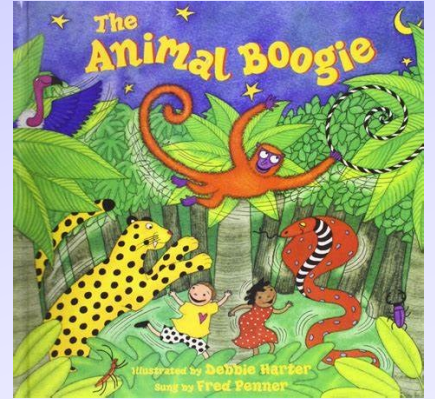




Dear Parents and Carers 09.05.2022

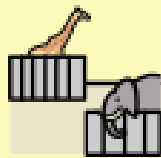

With the warmer weather approaching, please ensure children have suncream applied before sessions and that your child has a sunhat in their bags. @RobsackN

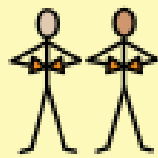
