

GRANTS FROM PRIVATE SOURCES

The Board of Education encourages the development of proposals to private foundations and other sources of financial aid for subsidizing such activities as innovative projects, feasibility studies, long-range planning, and research and development. All such activities shall meet the following criteria:

1. They are based on a specific set of internal objectives that relate to the established goals and objectives of the District.
2. They provide measures for evaluating whether or not project objectives are being or have been achieved.
3. The execution of all projects conforms to state and federal laws and to the policies of the Board.

All grant proposals shall be approved by the Board before being submitted to the funding agency. The superintendent shall establish administrative guidelines for the processing of proposal ideas to the Board for its approval.

The District shall not discriminate in the acceptance of bequests and other aids, benefits or services to students from private agencies, organizations, or persons on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, color, creed, pregnancy, religion, marital or parental status, sexual orientation or physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
