1. Welcome – 4:31pm
2. Approval of Last Meeting Minutes – Dr Rutherford motioned to approve the minutes and Nurse Havard seconded the motion. The vote to accept the minutes was unanimous.
3. Return to Instruction/Continuity of Services (RIPICS) – public comment/stakeholder survey in consideration of any needed updates. – Dr. Pitts shared the RIPICS plan with the committee and the survey that was sent for the update. He shared where the information is online and the Use of Funds. The majority of the ESSER III funds was spent on technology based on the survey data. Dr. Pitts will update the plan and will ensure the update is also translated in Spanish. He will send the updated plan to the committee when it is completed.
Dr. Pitts opened the floor for comments. One suggestion was that the email with the plan should have a brief explanation about it so parents can understand what it is before reading it.
4. New Business/Reports
 - A. COVID Update: Zero cases of COVID as of today districtwide. We had another vaccination clinic on April 23, 2022.
 - B. Child Nutrition: Selection of FSMC for 2022-2023 Technology created a page for Child Nutrition on the China Spring ISD website. We have submitted the RFP to TDA and are hoping it is approved soon.
 - C. Campus Safety: Shanna Sanders suggested that we start doing some assignments to parents and students of these social services activities when there are attendance issues. This could be a part of the plan used before going to attendance court. Officer Fray will be going to be trained in mental health and will be our district mental health officer starting next year. Shanna Sanders is getting ready for the trainings in the fall for staff and will add stabbing to the stop the bleed practice.

- Threat assessment – There have been 9 at middle school, 5 at the intermediate, 7 at the high school, and 4 serious ones at the elementary on the threat assessment list that are discussed with the team regularly and provided with necessary resources.
- D. Social Services Liaison: Resource fairs, parent summits, and services are not well attended, and Cindy Davis asked for the committee to reach out to community members to help get better attendance.
