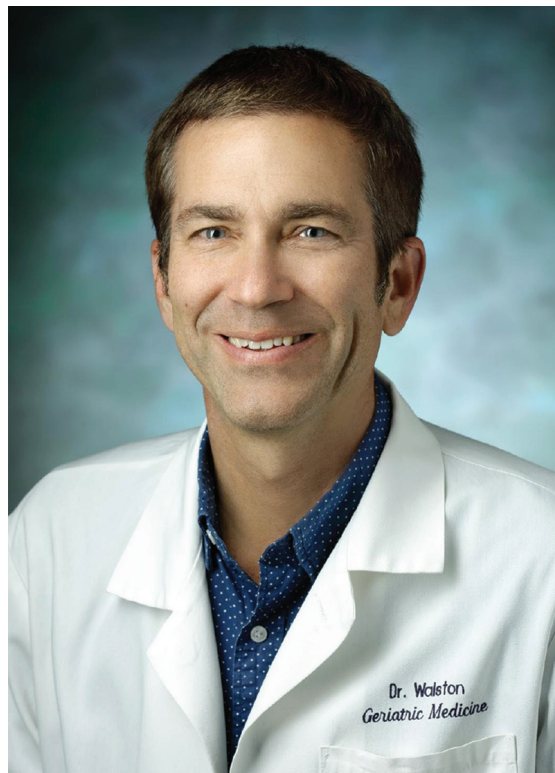


The Eastwood Hall of Fame 2019

A 1979 Eastwood HS graduate, Dr. Jeremy Walston has distinguished himself as an internationally recognized Professor of Geriatric Medicine and Gerontology at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. He plays a leading role in setting national and international research and patient care agenda for older adults.

- Leads the Johns Hopkins Older Americans Independence Center and is the deputy director of the Division of Geriatric Medicine and Gerontology at Johns Hopkins, which was ranked as the #1 U.S. Geriatric Program by *U.S. News and World Report* in 2017 - 2018 and in the top three nationally ranked programs for over a decade.
- Holds the Raymond and Anna Lublin Chair for Geriatric Medicine and Gerontology at Johns Hopkins
- Has over 200 publications in the medical literature and serves as the American Editor of the *Oxford Textbook of Geriatric Medicine*
- Has won numerous prestigious awards for his research including the Brookdale National Leadership Fellowship and the Glenn Award for Biological Aging Research
- Frequent invited speaker on aging-focused meetings in China, Germany, Spain, South Korea, and Saudi Arabia
