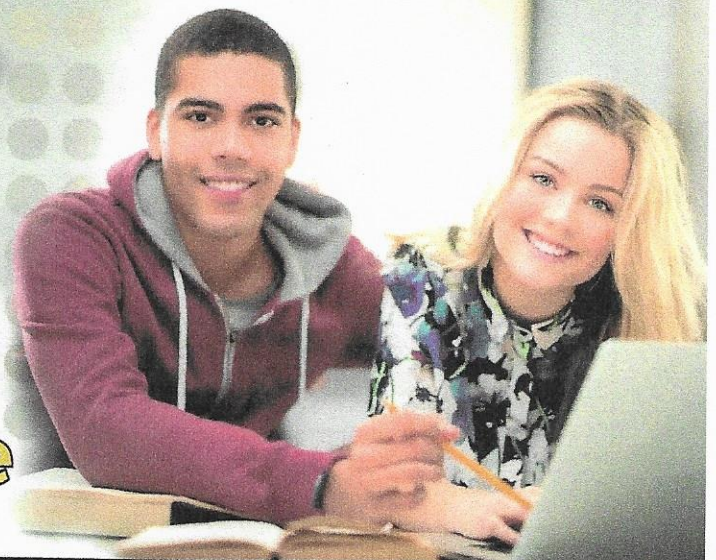

Dual Enrollment @ West Georgia Tech

Dual Enrollment classes allow students to earn **both** high school and college credit for degree-level core or technical classes.

Full tuition, mandatory fees, and cost of textbooks are covered.

Dual Enrollment hours will not count against the HOPE hours cap.

Many degree-level core classes taken at WGTC transfer to colleges and universities in the University System of Georgia.

HOW TO **apply**

Students entering 9th to 12th grade are eligible to enroll.

Submit a WGTC Dual Enrollment Student Participation Agreement.

Meet with your high school counselor prior to each semester of enrollment to discuss class options.
