What is **DUAL ENROLLMENT?**

Program Participation Requirements

The Dual Enrollment program is a partnership between WGTC and service area secondary school systems. Students must first meet the requirements of their local school system to establish eligibility for participation in any Dual Enrollment program with West Georgia Technical College.

Application Deadlines

November I for Spring Semester - April I for Summer Semester - June I for Fall Semester

To participate, a student should:

- I. Be enrolled in high school.*
- 2. Meet with his or her high school counselor to determine eligibility for a Dual Enrollment program.
- 3. Be on track for graduation.
- 4. Meet the minimum test score requirements for student's program of choice.

- *Some programs/courses have a minimum age requirement. **Some certificate programs may require a minimum algebra score.

Program Guidelines

- The purpose of Dual Enrollment is to offer additional educational opportunities to students while they are still in high school.
- Dual Enrollment courses can impact high school graduation and will impact high school GPA.
- A technical college instructor will teach all Dual Enrollment courses.

Academic Information

Dual Enrollment students receive dual credit (credit at the technical college and at the high school).

Failing a Dual Enrollment course may impact high school graduation and GPA, and may prohibit students from continuing in the Dual Enrollment program.

Attendance Policy

Dual Enrollment enrolled students must adhere to both the high school and technical college attendance policies.

Refer to course syllabus for specific requirements regarding course attendance. Any class work missed due to student absence *may* be made up at the discretion of the instructor.

Regulations

High school students who participate in Dual Enrollment are required to adhere to all high school and technical college rules and regulations. Please see the West Georgia Technical College student catalog (www.westgatech.edu) to review these rules and regulations.

West Georgia Technical College Dual Enrollment Student Participation Agreement

This release will remain in effect throughout enrollment as a dual enrolled student.

I. Dual Enrollment Requirements (reviewed by student, parent and high school counselor)

The student's individual graduation plan has been updated to reflect the plan of study through dual enrollment.

It is the student's responsibility to inform his/her high school counselor of any scheduling changes in dual enrollment class schedule.

A discussion about dual enrollment with a WGTC high school coordinator has occurred and all questions/concerns have been addressed.

The student will adhere to all policies and procedures of West Georgia Technical College for all courses taken with the college.

The student will be held to any attendance policy set in the course syllabus of the student's classes.

If the student drops or fails a dual enrollment class, it is understood that this could negatively impact the student's high school requirements for high school graduation.

The student's final grade in a dual enrollment course will become part of the student's permanent high school transcript.

The student is limited to taking I5 dual enrollment credit hours per term with WGTC. A counselor may not approve more than I5 dual enrollment credit hours total in STARS during a term.

The student will not be able to register for any dual enrollment classes until the Georgia Student Finance Funding application has been completed by the student at www.gafutures.org. The funding application must be completed before registering each term.

Students may be responsible for additional costs, such as course or lab fee/supplies, and/or fees charged for late or damaged textbooks.

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DUAL ENROLLMENTFunding Application Policy & Process

West Georgia Technical College Dual Enrollment Funding Application Policy

In order to serve all West Georgia Technical College students to the best of our ability, beginning summer semester 2019, the office of financial aid and the office of dual enrollment have enacted the following policy regarding funding application and dual enrolled students:

- All West Georgia Technical College dual enrolled students must complete a Georgia Futures funding
 application at GaFutures.org for the semester they wish to be registered prior to a WGTC high school
 coordinator registering the student for classes. If a WGTC dual enrolled student has not completed their
 funding application for the semester they wish to be registered for, the student will not be registered for
 classes.
- All high school counselors for West Georgia Technical College dual enrolled students must complete their
 portion of the Georgia Futures funding application for each dual enrolled student by the semester midpoint. If a
 student's funding application has not been approved by their counselor by the semester midpoint, the student
 will be purged from WGTC classes.

Steps to Complete Dual Enrollment Funding Application

A funding application must be completed every semester of Dual Enrollment participation.

- 1. Sign in to www.gafutures.org or create account
- 2. Enter your **Username and Password** information, then select **Sign In**.
- Dual Enrollment information can be found within the HOPE
 State Aid Programs tab.
- 4. **Dual Enrollment** is considered a state program and can be found by selecting **State Scholarships and Grants**.
- Select **Dual Enrollment** from the list of state programs to find information needed. The application can be found by selecting **Application Procedure and Deadline.**
- 6. Click on "Apply Now" and complete all required fields.

Dual Enrollment Funding Covers

- All tuition and mandatory fees
- Required textbooks (textbooks are loaned to students and must be returned at the end of the term)

Dual Enrollment Funding Does Not Cover


- Supplies required by some courses (example: uniforms, supply kits, background checks, etc.).
- Some program- or course-specific fees (example: lab fees, malpractice insurance fees, etc.)

Home-schooled students and students who do not have a social security number must submit a paper funding application.

Satisfactory Academic Progress

Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress with WGTC to maintain eligibility for Dual Enrollment funding. Students must maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA and 2.0 GPA for each semester. Students must also have a 66.6% completion rate for all courses attempted. This eligibility is determined at the end of each semester. If students do not maintain this eligibility then can be placed on Financial Aid Warning or Suspension and not be eligible for Dual Enrollment funds or other financial aid through WGTC.

Dual Enrollment classes do not count toward the total HOPE scholarship or grant cap hours that a student can use. This means a student can take DE classes in high school and still be eligible for a full HOPE Scholarship or Grant after graduation.
