## MINUTES:

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Esser.

II. Roll Call

Committee members Statz and Esser were present. Administrators Summers and Guttenberg were present. Board Member Meese, Administrator Weiss, and community member Richard Lampe joined the meeting for agenda item V.

III. Approval of Agenda

There were no changes to the agenda. Motion by Statz seconded by Esser to approve the agenda. Motion passed 2-0.

The committee reviewed the 2009-2010 second draft of the budget. Due to the recent announcement regarding the additional state budget deficit, the committee is recommending holding the district budget process until additional information is available.

The committee reviewed the proposed 2009-10 student fees. A revised document was handed out at the meeting. Motion by Statz seconded by Esser to approve the student fees as presented with the exception of high school girls and boys hockey fees. Motion passed 2-0. The high school girls and boys hockey fees will be tabled until the next committee meeting.

Summers reviewed a tuition request received from the Madison Metropolitan School District. This tuition request is regarding an open enrollment situation where a family has one student open enrolled from Waunakee but did not file the paperwork for the incoming kindergarten student. The committee requested additional information from Madison on this request.
