

AUTOMOTIVE TECHNICIAN

Inspect, repair, and maintain essential automotive components: engine, brakes, steering, suspension, electrical systems, tires, heating, cooling, and diesel mechanics.

COLLISION REPAIR

This hands-on program teaches the basic principles of auto body repair, metal work, basic painting, color matching, cost estimation, industry safety protocol, and structural analysis.

WHAT IS IT

For many of us, cars are an essential part of daily life. In our auto technology program, students learn how automotive technicians maintain these complex machines.

The average driver is involved in three to four fender benders in their lifetime. That's bad news for drivers, but good news for anyone considering a career in the collision repair industry.

COSMETOLOGY

FEATURED CAREER PATHWAYS

HAIR STYLIST/HAIRDRESSER

A hair stylist works in a salon or spa and cuts, colors, bleaches, and styles a client's hair. They analyze and recommend styles or treatments in order to provide the right image the client is looking for.

ESTHETICIAN

Identifies cosmetic issues with skin and applies treatments such as facials, skin conditioning, and blemish extractions to improve skin.

WHAT IS IT

Cosmetology is the study of cosmetic treatments to the hair, nails, and skin. Cosmetologists perform an essential role in helping people look and feel their best, and typically work in Beauty Salon spas or barber shops, but also work in retail locations like department stores, hotels, and cruise ships.

WHAT WILL I DO?

Hair stylists are trained on proper hair cutting and styling, and color and dying techniques. Nail technicians make sure that their client's fingernails and toenails are healthy and beautiful. Skin and makeup specialists provide treatments to make their client's skin feel smooth, soft and healthy while also applying makeup to make their client look their best.

AVIATION MAINTENANCE

The Aviation Maintenance program teaches the maintenance and repair of aircraft mechanical systems. Students are prepared for highly technical jobs in aviation mechanics. Students are guided through hands-on training by experienced instructors who ensure students are job-ready. ALA-AT offers testing for industry certification with the Federal Aviation Administration. This is a four year program.

AIR TRANSPORTATION

In the ground portion of flight school, students can earn their FAA private pilot certificate in a single engine aircraft. Students will also be eligible for certification for a remote pilots licence with UAVs (unmanned aerial vehicle). We have partnered with Embry Riddle Aeronautical University to deliver this program.

WHAT IS IT

Those who dream of hitting the skies can do so for a living, whether it be in the pilot's seat or on the ground. Careers in aviation offer many opportunities for advancement in piloting, engineering and mechanics, airport operations, and aircraft manufacturing.

WHAT WILL I DO?

Many aviation and aerospace manufacturing companies hire technicians and engineers to perform repairs and maintenance services on various types of aircraft before they are sold. Others may need technicians to perform tests and develop new elements for various aircraft. Those with a strong background and a degree in mathematics, science, or industrial engineering may fare particularly well in aviation.

NETWORK SECURITY

Network security is the protection of computer and network systems from digital theft, damage, or sabotage. Cyberattacks are external threats, centered on interrupting normal business processes. Network security focuses on efforts to detect, identify, and respond to external cyber threats and how to recover from them.

AUTOMATION & ROBOTICS

Automation is the process of using physical machines, computer software, and other technologies to perform tasks that are usually done by humans. Robotics is the process of designing, creating, and using robots to perform a certain task. Both use computer coding to create, design, and deploy software.

WHAT IS IT

Computers can be found today in almost every home, business, and industry. The demand for people with technology training is very high. Technology careers involve developing and maintaining computer systems and creating applications for individuals and organizations to conduct their everyday business.

WHAT WILL I DO?

If you work in technology, you might be a network administrator responsible for a company's entire network system. As a computer programmer, you can work on developing code that creates an application used by businesses to perform certain tasks. A business intelligence analyst might analyze data that helps an organization make better strategic business decisions.

Healthcare careers focus on the health and well being of patients. Work is generally in hospitals or clinics but can also be found in nursing facilities, offices, and people's homes.

This program opens future opportunities for researchers and technicians who work in laboratory settings to develop cures for diseases. You might work as a Health Information Specialist that keeps history of medical records for insurance or future use.

CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGIES

FEATURED CAREER PATHWAYS

CONSTRUCTION TECHNOLOGIES

Offers hands-on experience that teaches students how to master skills in construction. Students learn carpentry, electrical, HVAC, and plumbing skills, as well as learning and understanding how to read blueprints, site development, and material testing.

MASONRY

Theory and practical exercises will prepare students with the skills and knowledge necessary to gain entry-level employment in the masonry trade. Students will learn the use of hand and power tools, building layout, blueprint reading and estimating. Laying brick, block, and pouring and finishing concrete are covered in detail.

CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT

Students in construction management should plan to complete a construction management certification program or advanced degree.

WHAT IS IT

The construction industry is booming in Arizona, but is experiencing a shortage of workers. Construction workers help build the house you live in, the school you attend, the buildings where people work, and the roads you drive on. Most homes, buildings, and structures is built by construction workers, from designing the blueprints, to putting up the frame of a house or building, to installing the plumbing, electrical, heating, and air conditioning.

WHAT WILL I DO?

Carpenters put up the framework of the building, create cabinets and build out the framing for windows and doors. Skilled workers like electricians, plumbers, and HVAC technicians each contribute to the finishing details to make the home or building ready to move into. Construction managers plan, coordinate, budget, and supervise construction projects from start to finish. Construction managers may have a main office but spend most of their time in a field office onsite, where they monitor projects and make decisions about construction activities.

Business management is responsible for managing businesses as an owner, executive, or manager. Finance is the business of money. Financial service companies help manage and grow their client's money.

CULINARY ARTS

Culinary Arts refers to the art of preparing, cooking, presenting, and serving food usually in restaurants, but also cafeterias, catering, and food trucks.

HOSPITALITY

Hospitality careers involve the management, marketing, and operations of hotels and resorts, restaurants, entertainment attractions, and large-scale events.

WHAT IS IT

Hospitality is the business of recreation and entertainment. Hotels house people when they vacation or travel, focusing on their guests comfort and well-being.

Culinary arts is the preparation, cooking, and presentation of food and meals. You will usually work in restaurants as a cook or chef in the kitchen, but may also work in the front of the house in roles like servers or greeters. Catering is a big business that involves preparing food for large events.

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

Early childhood education focuses on teaching and guiding preschool children, giving them the building blocks to learn and be curious, while helping them adjust socially and interact with others. It's exposing young children to art, music, language, math, and social settings that help to improve their development.

EDUCATION PROFESSIONS

Education careers exist in kindergarten, elementary, and middle school, high school, college, and beyond. Teachers educate their students in traditional skills like reading, writing, and mathematics as well as develop values such as time management, personal responsibility and respect for others.

WHAT IS IT

Education is the teaching and training of people from preschool through high school or college. Education workers most frequently work in schools but can also be found in corporations, sports activities, libraries, churches, and after-school activities.
