
COVID-19 DECISION TREE – TK-12 & CHILDCARE (5.6.22) to Determine Isolation or Quarantine for Staff & Children





- ANYTIME a test is **positive** (regardless of vaccination status or absence of symptoms), **isolate at home** follow the **ORANGE** tree.
- 2. <u>All FDA-approved COVID tests</u> can be used for diagnosis or to end isolation/quarantine. (<u>Antigen</u> preferred to end isolation and for symptomatic contacts with COVID in past 90 days.) <u>Staff</u> may provide time-stamped photo as proof of at-home test result.
- 3. **Close contact**= someone sharing the same indoor airspace for a cumulative total of ≥15 minutes over a 24-hour period during a confirmed case's infectious period.
- 4. **OR** a health care provider has documented that symptoms are typical for their underlying health condition. In this case, schools may use discretion in determining when the student may return to school.
- 5. Wearing a mask is **strongly recommended** for those 2 years and older except when eating or sleeping.
