





## DEVELOP A HIGH SCHOOL & BEYOND PLAN



- Students start the HSBP in middle school, where they create a plan that builds toward a diploma and their long-term goals.
- Students outline how they will meet the high school graduation requirements and what they want to do after graduation.
- Student adjusts their plan throughout high school, based on changing interests and goals.
- The plan is shared with parents/guardians during the annual student-led conferences.

## MEET A GRADUATION PATHWAY



### Post-Secondary Education (2 or 4 Year)



#### SMARTER BALANCED ASSESSMENTS

Meet or exceed the graduation scores in the Smarter Balanced Assessments (SBA) in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics.



#### DUAL CREDIT

Earn at least one high school credit in ELA and at least one high school credit in math in dual credit courses (Running Start, College in the High School, and Career and Technical Education dual credit courses).



#### AP/IB

For both ELA and math, earn a 3 or higher on certain Advanced Placement (AP) exams or a 4 or higher on certain International Baccalaureate (IB) exams.



#### SAT/ACT

Meet or exceed the graduation scores set by SBE in the math and ELA portions of the SAT or ACT.



# MEET A GRADUATION PATHWAY



## Military



### ASVAB

Meet standard on the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) by scoring at least the minimum established by the military for eligibility to serve in a branch of the armed services.

## Career/Technical Field



### CTE SEQUENCE

Complete a sequence of Career and Technical Education (CTE) courses: two or more high school credits of CTE courses in a progression tailored to the student's goals and relevant to the postsecondary pathway(s) outlined in the student's High School and Beyond Plan. The sequence may be comprised of courses within the same CTE program area or courses within more than one CTE program area.

## COLLEGE in the HIGH SCHOOL



- Earn college credit from CWU or U of W while taking a course at Southridge (May also earn an additional .5 elective per course)
- Must meet eligibility requirement from the institution offering college credit (test in Writing, Reading and/or Math)
- Credits placed on high school transcript and college transcript.
- *Students pay the college for courses at a reduced rate = \$175 / 5cr*
