

# Registration Frequently Asked Questions



How <b>many</b> classes do I sign up for?	You need to sign up for 6 courses each semester plus alternates in case your preferred classes aren't available.
Do I have to register for <b>6 classes</b> ?	Yes, non credit classes count toward your 6 (open period, seminary)
What if I'm a senior and don't need a <b>full schedule</b> ?	Register for Open Period (Other Courses--Leadership, Seminary, Assistants) to replace each semester course you are not taking.
How do I know <b>which class</b> to take (e.g., <i>which Math</i> ) etc.	You need to complete your Course Audit Worksheet to determine which classes you should take next year. Your current teachers can provide suggestions.
I go to <b>Seminary</b> , how do I indicate this?	In the "Other Courses--Leadership, Seminary, Assistants" section you will choose "Off Campus" as one of your electives
I want to take <b>Leadership</b> and I can't find it.	Leadership can be found in the "Other Courses--Leadership, Seminary, Assistants" section
What if the class I want <b>isn't available</b> on my registration page? <b>PART 1</b>	Some students take courses outside of what is normally offered to other students in their grade (e.g., <i>a freshman taking Honors Pre-Calculus</i> ). <i>If your course is not available to you, fill out the <a href="#">Help Form</a></i>
But if I don't pick something, I won't have enough courses and the system will not allow me to submit... <b>PART 2</b>	Choose the next closest class. The <a href="#">Help Form</a> has a spot to let us know what you picked and need to have corrected.
What if I need to <b>make up classes</b> ?	Most sections allow students to choose more than what is required in a year (e.g., students may choose up to 4 English semesters). You may choose to make your credits up this way; if you are a junior or senior you will see a "Credit Recovery" sections for you to choose a 7th hour APEX class.
Where do I find <b>zero hour</b> courses?	Zero-hour classes are in the sections they fit with (e.g., Zero-hour government is in the Social Studies sections).
I intend to go to <b>Tri-Tech</b> , why do I need to pick 6 classes too?	Not all students get accepted into Tri-Tech. If you don't get in and haven't chosen classes, you won't have a schedule.
I intend to go to <b>Running Start</b> (CBC or WSU), why do I need to pick 6 classes?	Not all students get accepted into Running Start. When you meet with your counselor later in the spring to choose Running Start classes, we will remove your selections from Southridge.
My registration page asks me to choose a Science or English <b>Alternative</b> . What if I don't?	Frequently one or more Science or English classes don't have enough requests for the class to make it onto the schedule. If you choose that class, or if the class is overfull and you don't make it in, your schedule will have an empty spot and you will need to choose from whatever classes are left when you return to school in the fall. <b>SO CHOOSE AN ALTERNATE!</b>
I made a <b>mistake</b> , what do I do? <b>PART 1</b>	You may make any changes to your requests through the registration window.
How long do I have to fix it? <b>PART 2</b>	Fix mistakes within the registration window. If you realize you made a mistake after the enrollment window try filling out the <a href="#">Whoops! Form</a> . We will try to be flexible. Once we can no longer accept changes, the form will no longer accept responses.
No matter what I do, I <b>can't submit</b> my requests.	Read and follow all error messages. Make sure you have enough credits selected (not just courses, some courses are not credit bearing).
What is the <b>timeline</b> for registration?	The registration window will be open for 2 weeks starting February 16th.
When do I have to have this <b>finished</b> ?	The registration window will be open for 2 weeks starting February 16 <sup>th</sup> .
