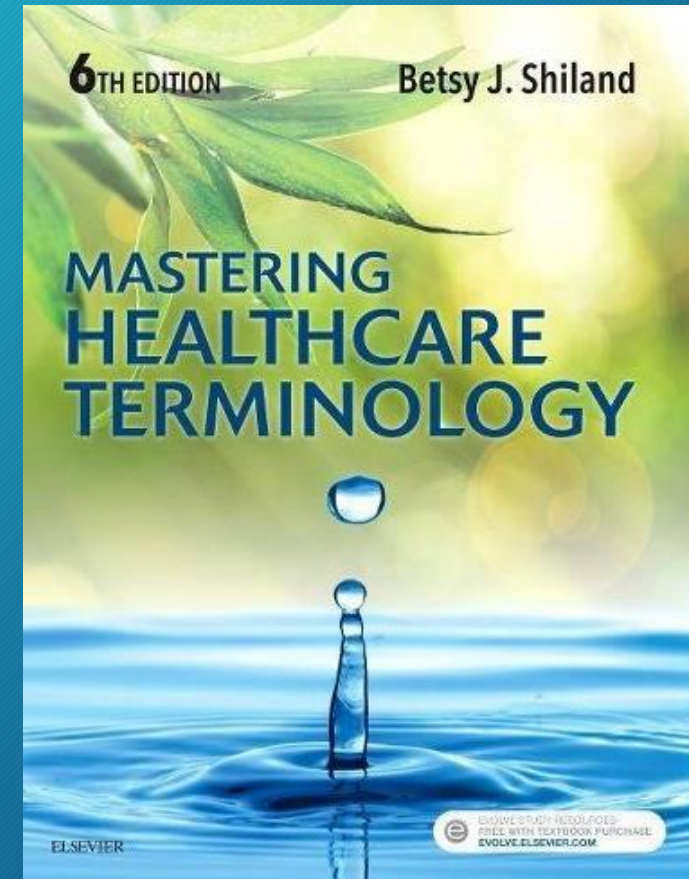
Example - Subungual Hematoma

- 3 Classes
 - Introduction to Sports Medicine
(Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors)
 - Advanced Sports Medicine
(Juniors or Seniors)
 - Clinical Observation - must be enrolled in $\frac{1}{2}$ or $\frac{3}{4}$ at the same time
(Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors)

Introduction to Sports Medicine

- Basic Introduction to the Medical Field

 - CPR and First Aid
 - Basic Anatomy of the Human Body

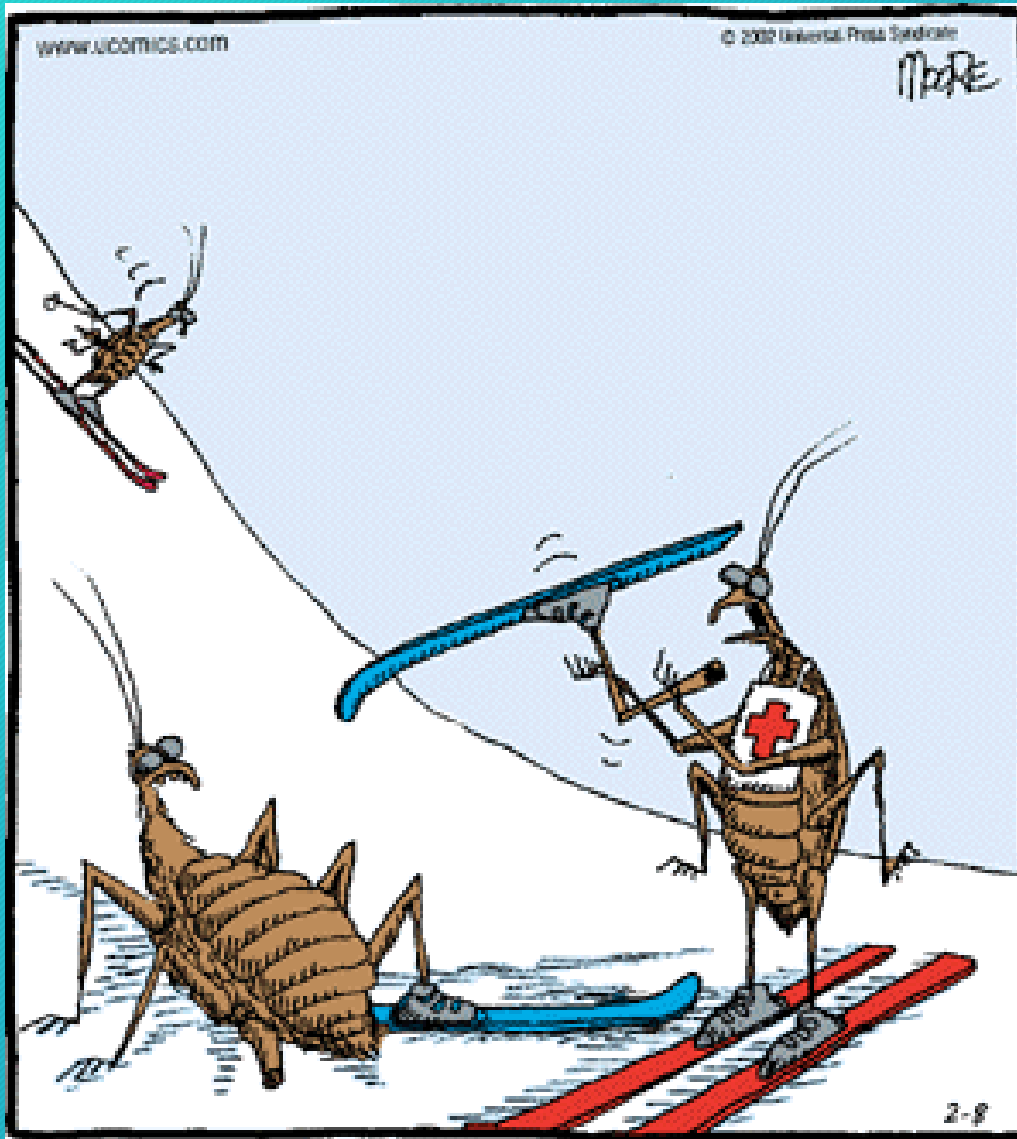
