

**Town of West Hartford Proposes Substantial Amendment
to Community Development Block Grant
2020 Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan**

This notice informs interested persons of a Substantial Amendment to the Town of West Hartford Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Annual Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2020, which is part of the 2020-2024 CDBG Consolidated Plan. As part of the CARES ACT, HUD awarded \$963,044 of CDBG-CV funding to assist with needs related to COVID-19. CDBG-CV was included in the Town's 2020 Annual Action Plan. The purpose of this Substantial Amendment is to add a new Project for CDBG-CV funding.

The change in allocation use of these expended funds is-below:
Substantial Amendment for Plan Year-2020

CDBG-CV Allocation \$963,044.00

Adding a new Project: Prevent, Prepare for, and Respond to COVID-19.

To comply with HUD regulations, Town of West Hartford will make available to the public a copy of 2020-2024 revised Consolidated Plan for a review period of **30 days**. The **2020 report** will be available for review and comment by West Hartford residents from **Tuesday, May 10, 2022, to Friday, June 10, 2022**. West Hartford will resubmit its report to HUD after **June 10, 2022**, to reflect use of CDBG-COVID-CV funds.
