featuring family members of the film's subjects.

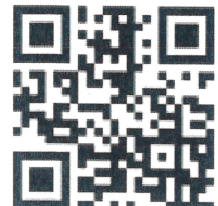

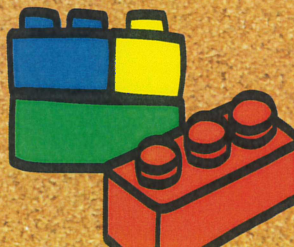
