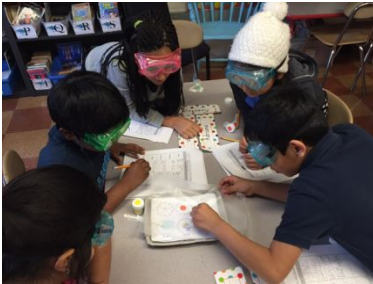




KT Murphy Elementary School
