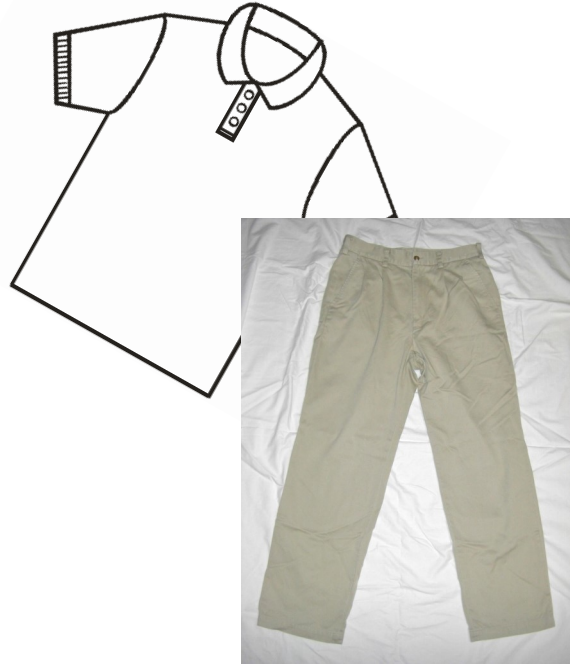

#### **Tardy Guidelines**

It is extremely important students arrive to class on time. If they receive a tardy, the following consequences will occur.

1st Tardy: WARNING

2nd Tardy: WARNING

3rd Tardy: Phone call home

4th Tardy: Lunch Detention

5th-6th Tardy: Two Hour Detention on Tue/Thur.

7th Tardy: 1 Days ISS

8th Tardy: 2 Days ISS

9th Tardy: 3 Days ISS

10 or more: 2 Detentions & a Full Day of ISS

Tardies will restart each quarter; however, consequences not served will be enforced.
