This school came on board adding a new grab n go breakfast location this year after Wayne County High School had made so much success with its alternative breakfast including grab n go and second chance breakfast. The staff go the extra mile to make it happen knowing how important breakfast jump starts and prepares for the school day. Casey Holt, FS Manager now serves an average of 347 students up from last Spring, when served 206, (41% increase). Wayne County Middle received a Kellogg's and Action for Healthy Kid's mini grant in SY 2012 .
