

Swim Parent Information

Welcome to the Watertown City School District Summer Swim Program. All classes are based on the philosophy of the American Red Cross Learn to Swim Program and are geared towards school aged children. Classes meet 5 days a week, Monday through Friday for 3 weeks. Parents are allowed to observe their child's class on the *first and last day of each session*.

Session 1: June 27 - July 15, 2022 (No Class on Monday July 4th)

Session 2: July 18 - August 5, 2022

General Pool/Class Information

- Students will be brought into the school for their lesson at the top of the hour. After the lesson is over, Instructors will bring the swimmers out at 10 minutes to the hour and supervised until their pick up. If you are unable to arrive at pick up time, (for your child's safety and so that you will be aware of where they will be) we will bring your child back into the pool area at the start of the next class.
- All swimmers should wear shoes they can put on and take off by themselves. Crocs, slides, flip flops made for water are the easiest. Swimmers must wear a swimsuit **to and from** lessons. Please have your swimmer bring a towel.
- The pick-up and drop-off location for the **WHS Pool** is located outside the pool doors at the corner of the WHS Building between Case Middle School and the high school.
- The pick-up and drop-off location for the **WILEY Pool** is located in the parking lot above the tennis courts, labeled Walker Doors. We ask that all swimmers at the Wiley Pool be picked up and dropped off **at the door** for safety reasons. We do not allow swimmers to run over the grass hill or across the parking lot.

If you have swimmers at BOTH Pools -

- Drop off at WHS 1st, then Wiley last
- Pick up at WILEY 1st, then WHS last
