



- NISD has been a fast-growth district for 20 years and regularly updates demographic projections.
- Demographers annually provide next year's projections at this time of year, and the expected growth is explosive.

Updated Growth Projections

- **Projected student growth has doubled** for the next five years.
 - December 2020 projections indicated 5,242 additional students in five years.
 - December 2021 projections now indicate **10,001** new students over the next five years.
- New projected enrollment in five years 37,370 students.
- New projected enrollment in ten years 46,069 students.



Planning for Surge in Growth

- NISD Board and administration has begun **adjusting plans** to account for long-term surge in student enrollment growth.
 - Adjusting staffing needs (attrition plan due to budget cuts is no longer necessary) and initiating efforts to proactively hire additional staff.
 - Monitoring current hotspots (such as Haslet Elementary), analyzing impact of projected growth on school capacity, evaluating impact on long-range facility plan.


