# **COURSE OFFERINGS & PRICES**

#### I Original Credit Courses

All original credit math courses are honors level, blended courses\* \$440 residents - \$640 non-residents

Algebra I\*\*, Geometry, Algebra II, & Pre-Calculus (\*\* offered only to Haverford Township students)

Work Study (1 credit maximum = 200 hours worked) 11th & 12th Grade: only with Guidance Counselor approval \$240 resident; \$340 non-resident

II Repeat Credit Courses All repeat courses are level-3\* \$240 residents - \$340 non-residents

Algebra I, II & Geometry: 9th-12th English: 9th-12th Social Studies: 9th-12th Engineering to Learn (ETL) 9th Biology 10th & 11th Chemistry: 11th & 12th

\*Summer School Mathematics is an online course that utilizes the ALEKS educational program (available 24/7). Courses will be conducted entirely online. On their own time, students must meet or exceed the minimum number of hours online and topics mastered in order to pass the course. In addition, each student must take an in-person Final Exam at the end of the course.

#### PAYMENT

Fees must be paid in full at the time of registration and will be returned only if the applicable course is cancelled.
