Students must take the required food components to make a reimbursable meal or they will have to pay for each item separately and will not qualify for a free meal.

Your child may continue to PURCHASE extra food items or ala carte items at a set price.

Students will NOT BE ALLOWED TO CHARGE EXTRA FOOD ITEMS AT ANY SCHOOLS NEXT SCHOOL YEAR!

Please inform your child of this policy and make sure they understand that cashiers will not allow charging of any items. Students must have money in their account or in hand to pay for extras.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

For your convenience use MY School Bucks to deposit money into your child's lunch/breakfast account or you may still send cash/check by the student for deposit into their account.
