## Reading

**P3:** Pre-reading, phonemic awareness

## Science

**Curriculum:** DIG (Outdoor Science Program)

**P3:** Living and non-living, weather systems and seasons, gardening

**P4:** Plants (roots, seeds, stems, leaves), trees, invertebrates/vertebrates (worms, insects, slugs), animal observations, gardening, water cycle

**P5:** Plants (chlorophyll, photosynthesis, growth), life cycles; wetlands, scientific method, gardening



## Music

Students grow in their love of music as they experiment with percussion, learn aspects of rhythm, sing songs, and dance. In addition to regular class sessions with our music specialist, teachers incorporate music into daily activities.

## Math

**P3:** Math Their Way Level 1  
Geometry—shapes, sizes  
Number concept—counting, recognition  
Patterning—copying, extending  
Classifying—simple attributes

**P4:** Math Their Way Level 2 / Singapore Math  
Geometry—parallel/perpendicular, angles/sides, rotations  
Number concept—number sentences  
Patterning—extending, creating  
Classifying—multiple attributes  
Graphing—concrete, symbolic

**P5:** Math Their Way Level 3 / Singapore Math  
Geometry—complex shapes, reflections, symmetry  
Number concept—grouping, recording  
Patterning—symbolic representations  
Classifying—complex attributes  
Graphing—symbolic, abstract

**P3 Character Qualities:** Self control, kindness, helpfulness

**P4 Character Qualities:** Kindness, patience, gentleness

**P5 Character Qualities:** Self control, responsibility, empathy, perseverance, encouragement, compassion, truthfulness

## Handwriting

**P3 Curriculum:** Handwriting Without Tears Level 1  
**P3 Content:** Writing name, coloring, tracing, upper case letters

**P4 Curriculum:** Handwriting Without Tears Level 2  
**P4 Content:** Pencil grip, upper and lower case letters, writing name

**P5 Curriculum:** Handwriting Without Tears Level 3, Nellie Edge  
**P5 Content:** Pencil grip, upper and lowercase letters



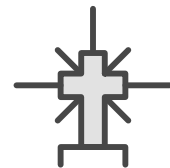
