1. Call to Order

Daniel Salerno opened the Public Hearing at 6:01 p.m.

Salerno stated that the purpose of the public hearing is to receive input and public participation regarding the draft report of the Charter Revision Commission to the Common Council regarding the proposed amendments to the City's Charter. He commented that the Commission Chair is ill and that she had asked him to run the public hearing. He noted that the Commission has had between 9-11 meetings and has received comments from the public during those meetings. He also noted that the Commission plans to have at least one other meeting to discuss the Draft Report.

2. Public Comment Related to the Draft Report to the Common Council regarding Proposed Amendments to the City of New Britain.

Salerno opened the floor to public comment and asked participants to limit their speaking time to three minutes and to state their name and address.

Alderman Desiree Costa – 193 Amherst Street, New Britain – complimented the Commission on a job well done, noting how the group not only worked well together but also presented thoughtful, diverse thinking. She stated that *The Herald* published a summary of the Charter revision process and urged members of the public with questions to review the article.

Salerno asked for additional comment from those present. There was no further comment.
