Main purpose of the role: To deliver sports sessions for Bede's Senior School

Main duties and responsibilities

- **1. Vision:** Deliver an overall vision for the trust for a 5 year period with quantifiable targets and actively promote the Team Bede's values.
- **2. Performance**: To support the Senior School Director of Sport in developing a long-term programme which facilitates team and individual growth, as well enabling local recognition.
- **3. Participation**: To help develop a long-term programme, enhancing participation and delivering high quality coaching across the programme. To promote the sports programme and advantages of overall fitness to all participants.
- 4. Trust wide contribution: Provide coaching manuals and CPD to wider staff. To ensure pupils wear the appropriate kit and behaviour in the correct manner, promoting Team Bede's ethos and help with the sanctions procedures. To help organise and participate in pre- and post-season tours and training.
- **5. Outreach and recruitment:** To create significant and longstanding links and relationships with appropriate schools and clubs.
- **6. Health & safety**: To support the Head of Sport with input to all related Risk Assessments, Health and Safety procedures, and other related legal documentation. To comply with all such procedures.
- **7. Finance.** To seek ways to gain revenue To work with the Head of Sport to utilise the budget efficiently and effectively, including planning for future facilities.
- 8. **Development:** Helping discover links with professional local clubs and National Governing Bodies seeking funding and beneficial developments.
- **9. Communication and relations with parents:** To complete detailed reports for participants as well as awards.
- **10. Income generation:** To ensure the Sports Complex generates Income and meets yearly targets.
- 11. Trust wide contribution: Contributing to the wider development of the Trust.
