Science, World Arts & more!

In Science, the 7th graders have started their new project, "Go With The Flow." They're learning about energy and matter flow and how they can teach others about it using a narrative.

In World Arts they have finished their project "World Arts Excellent Adventure," where they had to make an inference and bring a historical figure to life.

In 7th Grade Math, they are still in their unit "Animals." They are designing and building models of a house for an animal of their choice.

This is Mr Rivas, our site director and 7th grade social studies teacher. He decided to become a teacher around 7th grade because of an inspiring teacher.


Mr. Rivas' favorite project is "We know the way to San Jose." They even got the city involved!

On Wednesday, August 28, 1963, Martin Luther King Jr. delivered his famous "I Have A Dream" speech during the March on Washington. In commemoration of him, we celebrate his birthday each year on January 17th.
