Of course, I hope that you will choose to read more books on your own.

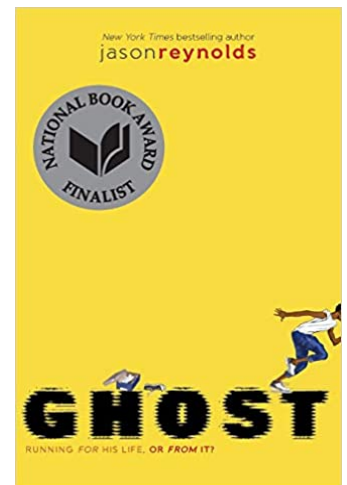
Summer Reading Assignment

Required Choice Book

Read one choice book.

- You may **not choose** books **that you have read previously or have been read to you**.
- Your choice book should be **age appropriate**. If you are in doubt, do **not** choose it.
- Your book must have at least **150** pages.
- You should **not** read the following books because you will read them later as an assigned book:

The Outsiders
The Giver

To Kill a Mockingbird
Night

The Miracle Worker
Warriors Don't Cry

After we return to school in August, you will write a **review** of your choice book.

- The review will include the following information: the **characters, plot, setting, conflicts, and themes**.
- You may take notes while reading, but you are not required to do so.
