VENDOR QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1. From page 12: Providing a minimum of 1 full day and 2 half day follow-ups per school of training per level, how many buildings do you anticipate being involved? We see you have three high schools, an alternative 6-12 program, and two alternative high school programs. Would you like training in 6 buildings?
This is for the three high is schools—2 comprehensive over 2000 students and one magnet with 650 students.
2. Are you anticipating paying for all years at once or are you thinking of paying annually?
Annually, but the contract will be for 5 years.
3. Are you seeking pricing for five years (page 4) or six years (page 13)?
Five years as stipulated in the pricing structure (page 16). (Page 13 is a typo)
4. Is the district looking for only College Prep and Honors, or are you also in need of general HS Chemistry?
CP and Honors
5. Page 15 refers to an autographic signature. Are we able to use an electronic signature?
That should be ok for documents submitting with a proposal.
6. The terms of agreement of page 4, Section 3 state the pricing shall remain in effect for five years. On page 13, under Section i., Details of the materials, etc. you are requesting a price proposal for 6 years. Are you able to clarify which is correct?

7. Page 13, Section iii., Bullet 3 “Provide pricing information per day”: would you please clarify that this is referring to Professional Development?
Yes to the PD
8. Would the district like to receive print samples at this time?
Print sample would be fine
