VENDOR QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

1. You mention the initial term of the contract will be the 2022/2023 school year through the 2025/2026 school year and that pricing will be effective through these dates. Does that mean the rates we provide on our cost sheet must be the same for each of those school years, and can only change for the optional 2026/2027 school year? Or can they change each year of the contract?

Yes, prices can change from year to year. It is the vendor's responsibility to bring the high quality services at a competitive rate.
2. Do you require resumes & licenses of potential school psychologists to be included in our proposal?

Yes, upon start of a contract.
3. How should we be completing Section 2 of the Contractor Verification form? We cannot guarantee that any school psychologist who is available for hire now will be available at time of award, so we cannot have a clinician sign any bid paperwork until after award?

Please follow the guidance in the RFP. The form needs to be completed with the submission of the contractor's proposal to SPS. The purpose of this form is to conduct a "background check", for lack of a better word, on any current or past employees of the contractor who have had direct contact with children while employed by a school district.
