Timeline

Students are expected to arrive on time and ready to go. Students will leave any personal belongings they bring in the gym.

- 6:15PM Graduates report to gym
- 6:30PM Line up for processional
- o 7:00PM Ceremony begins

Immediately following the ceremony, graduates will leave the stadium and pick up their diploma inserts on the walkway. ONLY GRADUATES will be permitted on the walkway. After receiving their diploma, they can pick up any personal belongings in the gym before departing.

Commencement Guidelines

- 1. All school lots can be used for parking. Please do not park on the grass. Those with State-issued handicapped placards can park in any spaces marked handicapped parking. There will be extra spaces marked for this event. In addition, we will provide transportation to and from the field.
- 2. Handicapped seating will be available in the first rows of bleachers and on specific areas of the track. One accompanying guest may sit with the individual that requires the seating. To reserve handicapped seating, <u>Click here</u> to complete the form by June 8th..
- 3. **Pay attention to directional signs.** Some areas are reserved for graduates only.
- 4. The following items are prohibited at the ceremony: latex balloons, horns or other loud noise makers, smoking of any kind, alcohol.
- Those experiencing COVID like symptoms are to refrain from attending. Please see the Wellness Screener.

FAQ

How many tickets do I get? Tickets are not required for this year's graduation.

Is there a rain date? Yes. The rain date is June 11th time TBD) Students would have to report to the gym 45 minutes before the determined time.

When will I receive my cap and gown? These items will be distributed at the first practice on June 8th.

Will the district stream the event live? No. Streaming is not an option this year.
