We hope to convince them to return in the fall so we can give them a proper send-off!

I want to recognize our seniors who have finished a most memorable year and have now graduated from Canton South High School. I am proud of our students and staff, and am thankful we have found unique ways to celebrate their accomplishments!

Considering the recent events surrounding the tragic death of George Floyd and the ensuing nationwide protests, as a school community, we must be there for each other and continue to show the compassion, empathy and humanity that all people deserve.

The Canton Local School District is an inclusive educational environment that celebrates diversity. Our Board of Education firmly supports its policies of anti-discrimination and equal opportunity for all. As a district, we will continue to have open and honest conversations about inclusion and diversity to equip our students and staff members to drive the necessary changes our world needs.

We are still waiting for the final determination of what school will look like next year. The Ohio Board of Education shared a draft of their Reset & Restart-Education Planning Guide for Ohio Schools and Districts, stating, "returning to school will look different than it did before March 16, 2020." A state advisory group is examining different models for the fall and we will review all the options before making a decision about what is best for our students and families. We will continue to share information with you about the upcoming school year through email messages, posts on our website, and through social media.

The new Faircrest Middle School project is moving forward, and we are excited to unveil some of the preliminary drawings on the back page of this issue. We are fortunate that this project is being completed with money from the taxes paid by our public utilities and our partnership with the Ohio Schools Facility. As is the cycle in school funding, the District will have a renewal issue in the spring of 2021, but the need is independent of our building projects.

Canton Local School District Renewal Levy – Spring 2021

NOT A NEW TAX

The Canton Local School District will have a
renewal levy on the Spring 2021 ballot. Here are
some facts to know about this renewal.

- Not a New Tax
- Renewal request is for 8.9 mills operating and 1.9 mills permanent improvement generating \$3.6 million per year.
- The need for the renewal has nothing to do with the new buildings! The renewal is needed regardless of construction.
- Operating dollars are used by the district to pay staff to educate, feed, counsel, support and transport students.
- Permanent improvement levy funds are used to help pay for buses, technology, maintenance equipment and building improvements.

Wildcat Preschool Registration

Preregistration for 2020-2021 school year is now open for the Wildcat Preschool Program offered by Canton Local Schools and the Stark County ESC at Walker Elementary. Availability is limited and based on a first come first serve so call ASAP to reserve your child's spot.

Morning and afternoon preschool classes are offered for three and four-year-old children who are typically developing, those that qualify financially, and those with developmental delays. Transportation is offered for 4-year-olds and those who qualify under special circumstances.

Our Wildcat Preschool provides an opportunity, through active and quiet play for children to grow through a variety of experiences. It is our belief that every child can learn and that the preschool experience should be positive, enjoyable, and rewarding for children and their families. Activities provided in our preschool are multi-cultural, play based, and child initiated. As the nurturing occurs in the preschool environment, the child develops communication skills and learns to interact with others in his/her world.

Each of our teachers are Ohio Department of Education certified with four-year Early Childhood Education degrees and the program has been rated as a 5 Star "Step Up to Quality" program. This is the highest rating a preschool can receive.

Kindergarten and New Student Registration

Canton Local School District is registering kindergarten and new students by appointment only. Please call 330-484-8019 for an appointment for the 2020-2021 school year.

Only one legal parent/guardian will be permitted at registration. Please no students.

Items needed for registration are:

- Child's birth certificate
- Two proofs of residency (see below)
- Vaccination records
- Child's social security card
- Custody papers if applicable
- Parent/Guardian ID

PROOF OF RESIDENCY

Proof of residency is required of all students registering at Canton Local and must be submitted to the school with the registration form. Parents/Guardians must document residency by providing the school with TWO current (less than 3 months old) approved proofs of residency as listed below. PLEASE NOTE: Post Office Boxes and Cell Phone Bills have no Service Address and therefore are not accepted.

Acceptable Utilities: Electric, Gas, Water, Sewer, Cable/Internet. The utility bill must show matching service and mailing address in the name of the Parent/Guardian.

Other Acceptable Documents: Monthly mortgage statement, lease/rental agreement (signed), pay stub, insurance statement, car payment statement, government agency letters, etc. with parent's name and address.

WALKER'S END OF YEAR CELEBRATIONS



Class of 1965 Reunion Update



Middle School Building Project Update



We are excited to share the first renderings of the new Canton South Middle School! The new middle school will be located on the corner of Route 800 and Ridge Ave, just south of Canton South High School. The renderings of the new school are what you will see from Route 800. Work on this building will begin in the fall of 2020 and be completed in May 2022. This building is being funded in partnership with the Ohio Schools Facilities Commission and with public utility taxes that the district has been able to set aside over the past several years.
