#### **New Interactive Online Menu**

The Canton Local School District encourages students to take advantage of the nutritious and tasty breakfast and lunch programs offered in each of our schools. In addition to our regular menu, we offer online, interactive menus that show the nutrition information for our breakfast and lunch items.

The menu lists the foods that will be served at school for the month along with nutrition and allergen information for that food item. Parents and students can customize and build menus based on dietary restrictions. For example, for Carbohydrate Counts, select the "Build a Menu" bar on the day your student plans to eat at school and choose the food items. The system will automatically add the carbohydrates for the meal at the bottom of the page.
