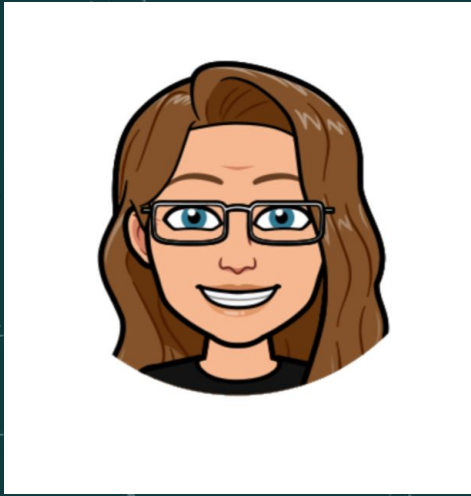

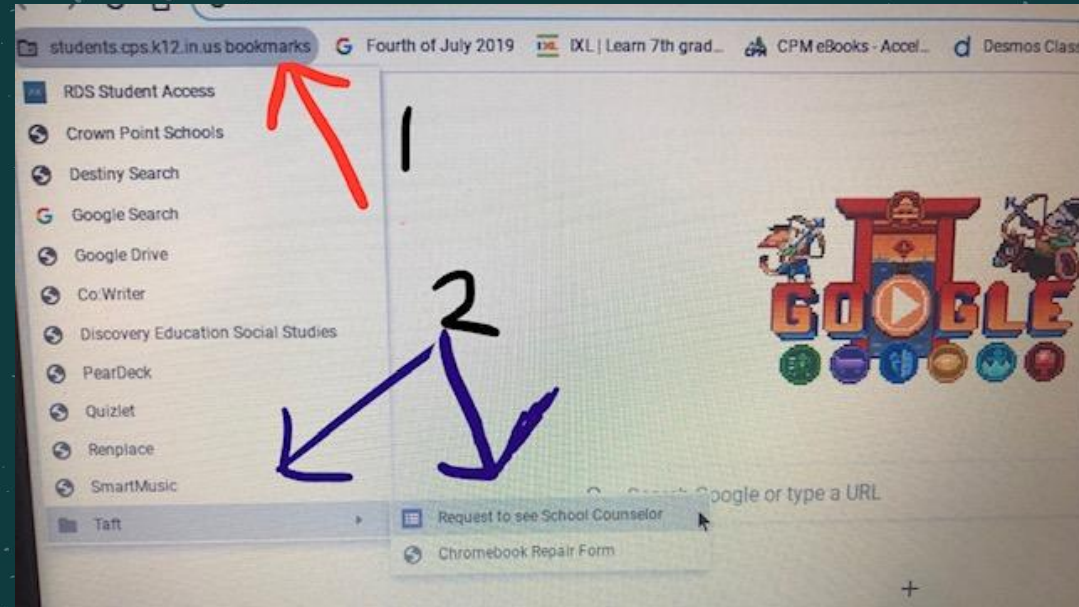


Why Would I Request to See The Counselor?

- ❖ Scheduling Changes
- ❖ Friendship Issues
- ❖ Coping Skills (Worried, Angry, Sad, Frustrated)
- ❖ Problems at Home
- ❖ Family Changes (Divorce, Sibling Issues, Blended Families)
- ❖ Family Illness/Death in the Family
- ❖ Harm to Self/Harm to Others

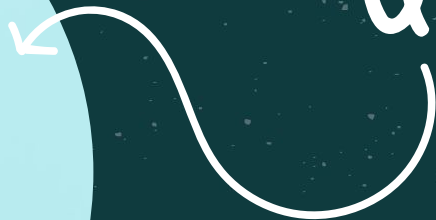
EXCEPT:
