# **THE HOUSE SYSTEM**

## **THE GRAY HOUSE**

House Color – Gray

The Gray House is named after Bro. C. Vincent Gray, S.M., who was the first African-American Marianist in the St. Louis Province of the Society of Mary.

## **THE LAMOUROUS HOUSE**

House Color – Gold

The Lamourous House is named after Marie Therese de Lamourous. She and her family provided shelter for Blessed Chaminade during his persecution at the time of the French Revolution.

## **THE MAUCLERC HOUSE**

House Color – Black

The Mauclerc House is named after the Rev. Francis Xavier Mauclerc, S.M., the first Marianist ordained in the United States in 1852.

## **THE MEYER HOUSE**

House Color – Blue

The Meyer House is named after Rev. Leo Meyer, S.M., who was the first Marianist stationed in the United States, and who founded the University of Dayton.

## **THE O'DONNELL HOUSE**

House Color – Green

The O'Donnell House is named after Bro. John O'Donnell, S.M., who served as a working brother at Chaminade College Preparatory School for forty-three years.

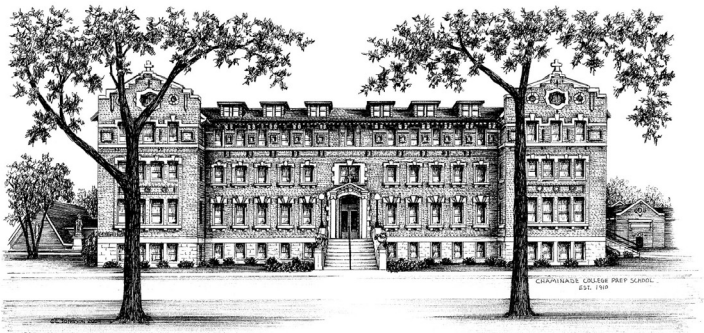

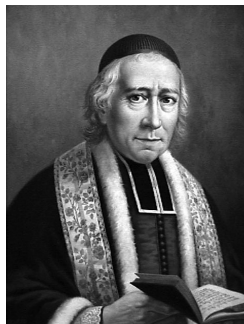

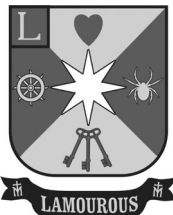
