# Who We Serve



- Any student who will be entering 6<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade, who resides within the Lake Washington School District boundaries;
- Students who receive support services (IEP, 504, ML, HiCap) are welcome to join online learning;
- In the 2022-23 school year, there is a possible option for students who live *outside* our boundaries to attend, as well!



# How We Serve

- Students attend one required class (Foundations) weekly, and have access to optional drop-in sessions throughout the week for additional help.
- Students who receive special services (IEP/ML) have additional synchronous learning opportunities with those specialist teachers.
- Content is delivered via partnership with Apex, and completed primarily asynchronously.

# Flexible Learning Opportunity

- Students may access synchronous and asynchronous work anywhere they have access to the internet;
- LWSD will provide technology for those students who need it;
- Teacher availability (school day) is similar to in-person learning and begins at 8:00am;
- School year follows LWSD school calendar (including closures);
- Students may continue to participate in sports, clubs, activities, etc. at their neighborhood school



# Flexibility for students with unique needs

- Partial enrollment with neighborhood school, Running Start, homeschool; WANIC;
- Competitive sports and activities that take students out of school for multiple days;
- Social-emotional needs (anxiety, stress, trauma) that preclude students from fully accessing brick & mortar learning;
- Working and/or parenting students who need a highly flexible schedule;
- Students for whom a “traditional” school just doesn’t work.
