Early Learning

A \$1.7 Million Investment in Early Learning Programs and Services

Over the next 10 years, more than 3,500 potential new K-12 students are expected to move into the district. Current projections show that 15 schools will be over capacity and we will have a deficit of nearly 2,500 K-12 seats for students by 2031. To help, SoWashCo Schools will ask voters to consider approval of a \$462.6 million bond on Aug. 9, 2022. A bond is the only method to raise enough funds for construction, renovations and additions to meet the needs of our growing community.



Vote Starting June 24

The 10-year facility plan includes expanding early learning services and programs for our youngest learners from birth to five.

If Approved by Voters:

- Continue early learning services and programs at Liberty Ridge Site II
- Convert Newport Elementary School into a complete early learning center to expand programs and services in:
 - Early Childhood Family Education for children and families
 - Preschool and Pre-K programming
 - Early childhood screenings, which are required before students enter kindergarten
 - Early Childhood Special Education
 - Assessments, evaluations, intervention visits and intake meetings for approximately 900 students (birth to 5)
