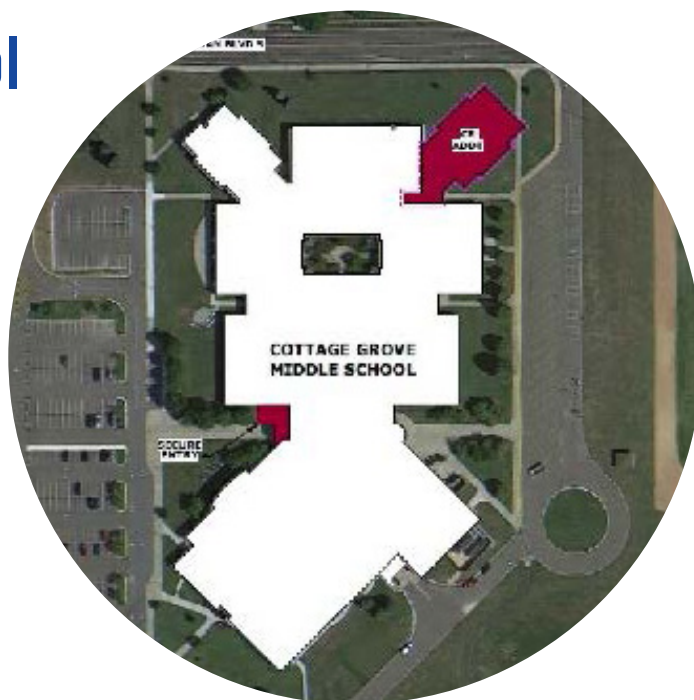

## Cottage Grove Middle School

### Addressing Future Growth and Building Safety

**Over the next 10 years, more than 3,500 potential new K-12 students are expected to move into the district. Current projections show that 15 schools will be over capacity and we will have a deficit of nearly 2,500 K-12 seats for students by 2031.** To help, SoWashCo Schools will ask voters to consider approval of a \$462.6 million bond on Aug. 9, 2022. A bond is the only method to raise enough funds for construction, renovations and additions to meet the needs of our growing community.



# Vote Starting June 24

The 10-year facility plan includes additions and renovations to accommodate up to 1,400 students.

### If Approved by Voters:

- Construction of a new classroom addition
- Renovation of kitchen serving line
- Construction of a new secure entry
