

- Reynolds speaks directly to young people in the book. He also reads his own work in the audiobook version—a great listening experience.


Jason Reynolds and Ibram X. Kendi appeared on The Daily Show with Trevor Noah to promote their book.


- Nick is 12 years old and a soccer player.

- It has been made into a movie.


